Some tragedies are so soul searing, so monumental, that their imprint remains permanently etched in the nation's collective consciousness. The terrorist attack on APS Peshawar seven years ago was precisely such an episode. Bakhtawar Cadet College arranged a ceremony within the premises of college to pay tribute to the young martyrs of Pakistan on 16th December 2021.

The heart tearing speech, poetry, tableau and song by the cadets portrayed the horrifying

image of the catastrophic time. Cadets of class matric performed a play which depicting how the innocent children lost their lives when TTP militants stormed the school and, in the most horrific orgy of violence imaginable, went from room to room slaughtering students and staff members.
