

Due to the high inflammation Covid19 across the country, the administration of BCCG planned to continue the teaching and learning process online the SO lockdown does not





### **BCCG Enhances the Soft Skills of Cadets**



### New Staff for Various Subjects Appointed


- The competent authority of BCCG appointed Ms Alia Korai on 21st June 2021. She was appointed as Lecturer in Physics.
