Allama Muhammad Iqbal's Day observed with much Inspiration

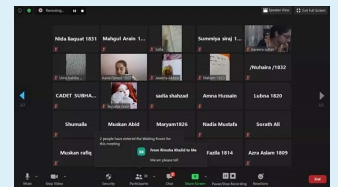
